

**MONONA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MEETING
OCTOBER 31, 2023**

The Monona County Board of Supervisors met in regular session at 8:30 a.m. o'clock on Tuesday, October 31, 2023, in the boardroom of the courthouse in Onawa, Monona County, Iowa with Chairman Fox presiding. Other, Supervisors present: Tom Brouillette and Vince Phillips. Supervisor Absent: None. Also, present was Auditor Peggy A. Rolph.

Motion was made by Supervisor Fox, seconded by Supervisor Phillips to approve the agenda. Vote on motion: Ayes: Fox, Brouillette, and Phillips. Nays: None. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Supervisor Phillips, seconded by Supervisor Fox to hire Randy Ping for the Building Maintenance/Grounds position. Vote on motion: Ayes: Fox, Brouillette, and Phillips. Nays: None. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Supervisor Brouillette, seconded by Supervisor Fox to authorize the Chairman's signature on status/payroll change report for Randy Ping, Building Maintenance/Grounds position for \$29 per hour, his old wage for Part-Time Temporary Custodian was \$27 per hour. Vote on motion: Ayes: Fox, Brouillette, and Phillips. Nays: None. Motion carried.

Present along with the Supervisors and Auditor for the Elected Official / Director Meeting were Jim Wigton, IT Director; Kevin Ewing, Sheriff; Ian McConeghey, County Attorney; Sandy Bubke, Zoning/Environmental Health Administrator; and Sharon Gries, Chief Deputy Assessor. Absent were Abby Riesberg, Treasurer; Josh Schaben, Conservation Director; Kelly Seward, Recorder; Patrick Prorok, EMA; Shawn Bellis, Secondary Roads Maintenance Superintendent; and Deleta Huffman, Secondary Road Office Manager. Activities were discussed and information was shared.

Drainage Clerks Bryan Phillips and Amy Borchardt-Sick were present for Drainage business. A discussion was held in regards to the process for obtaining trapping permits. The Supervisors directed the Drainage office to contact the Grapevine and publish a notice to the public for anyone who is interested in trapping in the Supervisors' Districts to contact the Drainage office. The Supervisors directed the Drainage office to compile a list of potential trappers after the required documents are completed. The list will then be forwarded to the Supervisors to determine boundaries for each qualified trapper.
