ORDINANCE NO. 12

AN ORDINANCE FORBIDDING JUMPING OR DIVING FROM COUNTY BRIDGES

BE IT enacted by the Board of Supervisors of Monona County, Iowa:

- SECTION 1. <u>Permitted Access Areas.</u> No person shall jump or dive from any bridge or other like structures located on or over any county road or highway.
- SECTION 2. <u>Penalty.</u> A person violating this ordinance shall be guilty of a simple misdemeanor and subject to a maximum fine of \$100.00 or up to 30 days in jail, plus surcharge and court costs.
- SECTION 3. <u>Repealer.</u> All ordinance or parts of ordinance in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.
- SECTION 4. <u>Severability Clause.</u> If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged unconstitutional or otherwise invalid, such adjudication shall not effect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not invalid or unconstitutional.
- SECTION 5. When Effective. This ordinance shall be effective after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
