

**MONONA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MEETING
FEBRUARY 28, 2023**

The Monona County Board of Supervisors met in regular session at 8:30 a.m. o'clock on Tuesday, February 28, 2023 in the boardroom of the courthouse in Onawa, Monona County, Iowa with Chairman Fox presiding. Other, Supervisors present: Tom Brouillette and Vince Phillips. Supervisor Absent: None. Also, present was Auditor Peggy A. Rolph.

Motion was made by Supervisor Fox, seconded by Supervisor Brouillette to approve the agenda. Vote on motion: Ayes: Fox, Brouillette, and Phillips. Nays: None. Motion carried.

Present for the Covid-19 Burgess Public Health update were Patrick Prorok, EMA Director, and via phone, Adam Hadden of Burgess Public Health. Adam informed the Supervisor that there were 30 cases for the month of February and 53 total deaths. Adam stated that the public health emergency would be ending March 31, 2023. Discussion followed with no action taken.

Judy Ehlers and Sharon Holverson of the Monona County Historical Preservation presented their annual report to the Board of Supervisors.

Motion was made by Supervisor Fox, seconded by Supervisor Brouillette to authorize the Chairman's signature on the Monona County Historical Preservation Annual Report. Vote on motion: Ayes: Fox, Brouillette, and Phillips. Nays: None. Motion carried.

The Monona County Board of Supervisors and Harrison County Board of Supervisors, acting as Trustees of the **McNeill Main Drainage District**, met in joint session on Tuesday, February 28, 2023 at 9:00 a.m. in the Basement Conference Room of the Courthouse in Onawa, Monona County, Iowa with Monona County Supervisor Chairman Bo Fox presiding. Other Monona County Supervisors present: Vince Phillips and Tom Brouillette. Deputy/Clerk: Lisa Jones and Bryan Phillips. Absent: None. Harrison County Supervisors present: Brian Rife, John Straight and Tony Smith. Clerk: Liz Lenz. Absent: None. Others present: Peggy Rolph, Auditor, Ivan Droessler, ISG Senior Civil Engineer, Spencer Pech, Graduate Engineer, Caleb Rasmussen, PE, ISG; and Dustin Wallis, Monona County Engineer.

FINAL PLANS AND SPECS PHASE 1 CONSTRUCTION

Engineer Droessler introduced the ISG firm who were present for the meeting. Spencer and Caleb will be working on this project going forward and Ivan informed the boards that he will be retiring in July assuring them that the project will move forward in good hands.

Rasmussen handed out a Specifications Summary and Cost Estimate sheet for Phase 1 Open Ditch Repairs. Due to some coordination with UPPR the main ditch project has been proposed in two phases, the first phase beginning at the Harrison Levee up to the UPPR Crossing. Once the work with the railroad is complete we can proceed onto Phase 2. The specs and bidding information was presented by Rasmussen to the board with bid times and dates discussed, crossings, stability issues, pilot channel to drain water etc. Copies of these documents are available for review in the Monona County Drainage Office, as well as the Harrison County Drainage Office. The Phase 1 cost estimate is \$1,458,054.20 with the majority of that cost being excavation work.

Pech reviewed bid letting dates, bonds and requirements. One of the contractor requirements within work area will be weed control during the project. The prebid meeting is tentatively scheduled for 10:00 a.m., Friday, March 10, 2023 in the Monona County Courthouse Board Room.

Work would begin this spring after the bid is awarded with a completion date of December 15, 2023.

Monthly progress payments would be scheduled with the two joint boards approval of payments. Official motion will be made by joint boards as set up at a later date when contract is awarded.

Bid letting time is set for March 21, 2023 @ 12:00 p.m. with consideration of the bids @ 1:00 with the joint boards.

A motion was made by Smith, seconded by Fox to approve the Plans and Specifications as filed and set a time and date for receiving and setting the bids. Vote on motion: Ayes: Fox, Phillips, Brouillette, Smith, Straight and Rife. Nays: None. Motion carried.

ENGINEERS’ REPORT FOR ANNEXATION

Rasmussen reviewed the Engineer’s Report for Annexation with the trustees.

After review, a motion was made by Phillips, seconded by Rife to tentatively approve the Engineer’s Report for Annexation and tentatively set the date and time of hearing for June 6, 2023 @ 1:00 p.m. at the Onawa Public Library. Vote on motion: Ayes: Fox, Phillips, Brouillette, Smith, Straight and Rife. Nays: None. Motion carried.

A copy of this document is available for review in the Monona County Drainage Office, as well as the Harrison County Drainage Office.

Present along with the Supervisors and Auditor for the Elected Official / Director Meeting were Abby Riesberg, Treasurer; Don Thompson, Veteran Affairs; Doug Kuhlmann and Josh Schaben, Conservation; Dustin Wallis, Engineer; Jeff Pratt, Sheriff; Jim Wigton, IT Director; Kelly Seward, Recorder; Patrick Prorok, EMA Director; and Sandy Bubke, Zoning/Environmental Health Administrator. Absent were Ian McConeghey, County Attorney, and Tim Peters, Assessor. Activities were discussed and information was shared.

Secondary Roads Engineer Dustin Wallis was present for Secondary Roads business. Motion was made by Supervisor Brouillette, seconded by Supervisor Phillips to approve internal/external posting for Maintenance Shop Foreman. Vote on motion: Ayes: Fox, Brouillette, and Phillips. Nays: None. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Supervisor Fox, seconded by Supervisor Phillips to approve miscellaneous utility permit for MidAmerican Energy for an UG single phase primary extension and new pad mount transformer in the area of 316 Hwy K45 Blencoe. They will bore 48” deep perpendicular to Hwy K45 and trench at back of right of way transformer at back of right of way. Vote on motion: Ayes: Fox, Brouillette, and Phillips. Nays: None. Motion carried.

Discussion item was the condition of the roads; no action was needed.

Sheriff Jeff Pratt, Sgt. Kevin Ewing, and Sgt. Jeremy Bellis were present for authorization to hire a deputy and to discuss hiring an additional deputy to take the place of an officer when Sheriff Pratt retires.

Motion was made by Supervisor Fox, seconded by Supervisor Brouillette to give authorization to hire Alex Boyle and Alexander Ehlers at the rate of \$26.24 per hour per union contract with a start date of March 20, 2023. Vote on motion: Ayes: Fox, Brouillette, and Phillips. Nays: None. Motion carried.

The Supervisors, along with the Auditor, Engineer, Sheriff, and Sergeants attended the Farm Bureau meeting at the Monona County Extension Office in Onawa. Various items were discussed. No action taken.
